The United Kingdom (UK) is in Europe. It is made up of 4 countries. England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Island.





Islands are pieces of land that are surrounded by sea.

Coastline	The boundary between the land and the sea or ocean. A coastline is part of an island, sitting along the edge of the sea. It is known as the sea or the shore.			
English Channel	A narrow part of the Atlantic Ocean that separates the south coast of England from France.			
Mountains	Natural raised part of Earth's surface that is higher than a hill.			
Lakes	A big area of water with land all around it.			
Moorland	Found in hilly areas and has poor soils and few trees.			
Physical feature	Features of our world that are natural e.g. rivers, seas, weather			
Human feature	Features of our world that have been made by humans e.g. pier
