China is a very big country a long way from the UK, where we live, on almost the other side of the world.

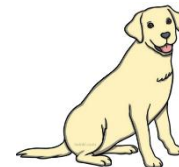
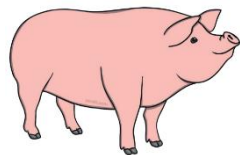
Every year during **spring time**, many people in China and other people from around the world, celebrate Chinese New Year.

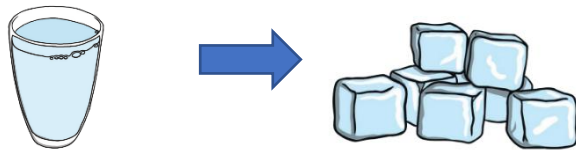
